Game Specific Rules

1.1b Terrain Effects Chart. The second sentence should read: "This chart does not have an entry for Major City (Mariupol') . . ." (Melitopol is incorrect).

1.4a Permanent Kerch Ferry Crossings. Add "Ferries only function in the Movement Phase."

3.6c add: The Odessa evacuation starts 26 Oct 41 if not triggered sooner.

The Common Rebuild Table (page 12 of the game-specific rule book) lists rebuilds that cost 2 Pax. Add "single-step Cavalry Division."

Playbook:

Mini-scenario 1, Scenario Special Rules, change "No off-map bases are available" to "The Soviet player may use the Novorossiysk Box normally"

Order of Arrival:

Axis Order of Arrival: On 5 Oct 1941 and several subsequent turns, the 22nd Infantry Division is listed as F24.26, F20.25, and F24.27. It should be F20.26, F24.26, and F27.24.

Soviet Order of Arrival: Add "26 Oct 1941, The Odessa evacuation starts this turn if not triggered sooner (see 3.6c)"

Random Event #24 - Activity Outside Crimea. Add "see OCS Rule 2.4" (which describes a Simulcast turn).

Random Event #35-41. Add: "Until activated, face-down Partisan units may not move and have no game effect. Should an Axis unit attempt to enter a hex with an inactive Partisan, the Soviet player immediately displaces it at least 2 hexes away to a hex with the correct terrain."

Counters:

Countersheet 2, front side. One of the German He.111H aircraft has its Transport Capability (1/2 T) printed twice.

The 22nd Panzer Division 140 Arty Rgt should be 16 Truck MA.

(Replacement counters will be included with the upcoming OCS title "The Forgotten Battles."

Map:

F46.08 is a Sea hex (please ignore the "nub").

F53.06/F53.07 should be a Blocked hexside.

Clarification: The Kuban River (flows past hex 60.07) is a Major River (the Major River blue borders are not as dark as they should be).

The Weather Track for 15-29 Nov should read 3-6 for Freeze instead of 5-6. A 100% sized corrected chart is below.
